### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing, the rules of the RS Aero Class Association and the rules and bye-laws of Chelmarsh Sailing Club.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

2.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the RS Aero 5, 7 and 9 classes.

#### 3. FEES

3.1 Race entry fee is £10.00. Bacon roll breakfast, Lunch, afternoon tea and hot drinks are available for purchase

#### 4. SCHEDULE

Registration from 9.30 am: Briefing at 10.30 am

First Warning not before 11.00 am

One race before lunch, two races back to back after lunch.

4.1 The regatta will consist of a maximum of 3 races.

#### 6. VENUE

Chelmarsh Sailing Club, Chelmarsh Reservoir, Hampton Loade, Bridgnorth, WV166BL.

NB Sat. Nav Error. Chelmarsh is on West side of River Severn. Last crossing north is Bridgnorth. Last crossing south is Bewdley. Hampton Loade ferry is seasonal pedestrian only.

#### 7. SCORING

7.1 The low point scoring system of RRS Appendix A will apply.

7.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

7.3 (a) When two or fewer races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When three races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### 8. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

#### 9. INSURANCE
