Club Boat Hire

Availability

Available to Sailing Members ONLY. Boat hire costs are £10/day for all boats except RS Aero which is £20/day reflecting the higher specification and racing rig on this boat.

The following boats are available for hire:

Training Boats

- Laser Pico x 6 sails and foils stored in power boat shipping containers
- Topper x 5 sails and foils stored in power boat shipping containers
- RS Feva x 2 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room
- Xenon x 3 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room
- GP14 x 2 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room

Fleet Boats

- Laser 4.7 rig x 1 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room
- Laser Radial rig x 1 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room
- Laser Full rig x 1 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room
- Solo x 1 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room
- RS Aero x 1 foils are stored on boats and sails in club training room

All the above boats are used for training and may not be available whilst training courses are being run at the club (see club diary for dates), if a particular boat is required, please check with instructors or Training Principal.

Hiring a Boat

- 1) Select the boat you would like to hire from the list above
- 2) Find the boat – locations are shown on the Boat Park Plan in the main lobby
- 3) Sail your chosen boat, treat with respect and enjoy sailing
- 4) Put boat away where you found it, properly secured.

General Notes to Hirers

- Club boats are expensive to keep and maintain, please treat them with respect and report any damage or faults through the defect book located by the main entrance door.
- It is recommended that users have a minimum RYA Level 2 or RYA Junior Stage 2 certificate or equivalent experience if taking club boats out, unless under supervision of experienced sailor or instructor.
- Please do not attempt to change the rigging on the boats, or remove items from the boats.
- After use, please return the boat the same location, make sure that sails and foils are returned to the locations above, boat covers are securely fitted and that the boats are securely tied down so they can be enjoyed by all club members. If you are unsure how to rig a particular boat, please contact Fleet Captains, an Instructor or experienced sailor for advice.
- The Club RS Aero is rigged as a racing boat and due to the fragile nature of construction this boat should only be used by experienced racing sailors, anyone wishing to try this boat should speak to the Aero Fleet Captain for help and advice.
- Members are reminded that they must follow "Buddy Sailing Rules" unless there is a manned rescue boat on the water. Please complete date on hire forms so we can reconcile hire payments.
