



Radio Controlled Model Sailing

Radio Control Yachting has been approved by the Committee.

The area allocated is from the far pontoon to the end of the boat park, and 2 small yellow marks positioned shore side of number 9 mark.

The times the area is available for sailing are the same as SUP, but not during club races. An R/C race meeting will be held once a week in the evening in the summer and/or Saturday mornings. Times to be announced.

Anyone wishing to sail R/C must be a Social member of the club, and complete a COVID-19 declaration (see below).

Coronavirus Procedure

Entry to the club and grounds is restricted to Existing Members (including social members) of the sailing club.

Activity will be based on the Pontoon and times chosen to avoid sailing times during the coronavirus restrictions. Buoyancy Aids to be worn on pontoons at all times

Social Distancing rules will be observed and all participants shall declare they have read and will abide by Chelmarsh Site Procedures

Equipment (e.g. radio control devices) will be disinfected, if used by more than one member, between users.

Wherever possible each member will be responsible for their own equipment and others should not touch or handle others equipment.

SUP members may be invited to act as a resource for retrieving equipment they will participate voluntarily and with respect to coronavirus rules (hand washing immediately post any activity maintaining social distance)
