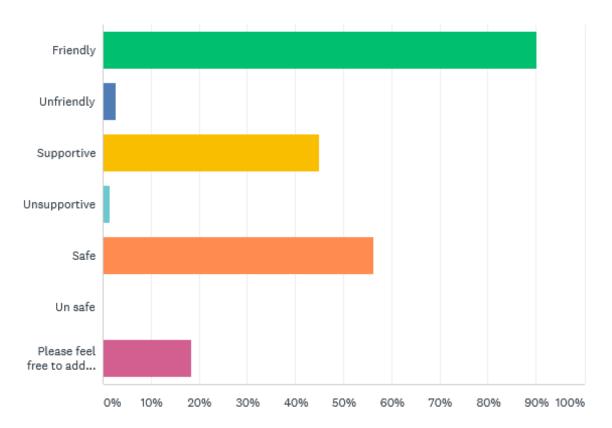

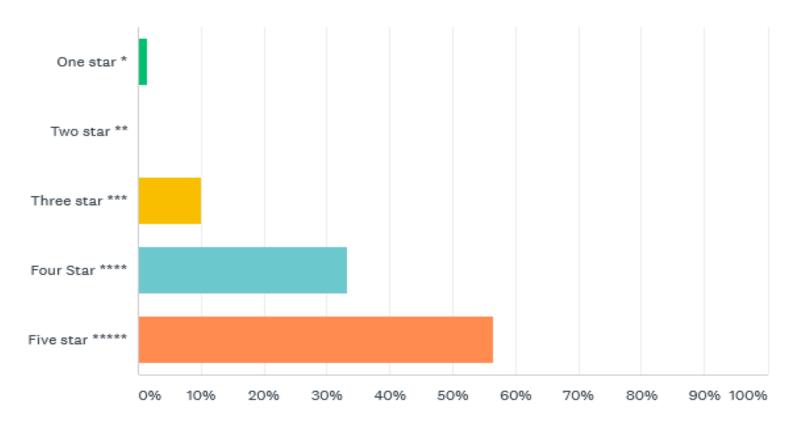
- great vibe real sense of being in this together. I just love the way everyone helps and smiles a lot.

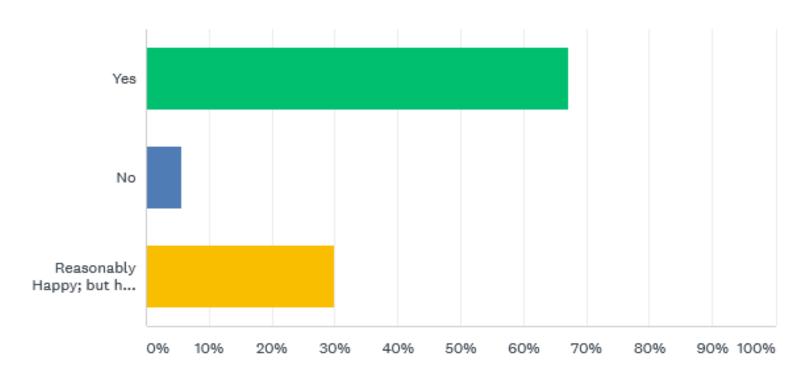

SUGGESTIONS:

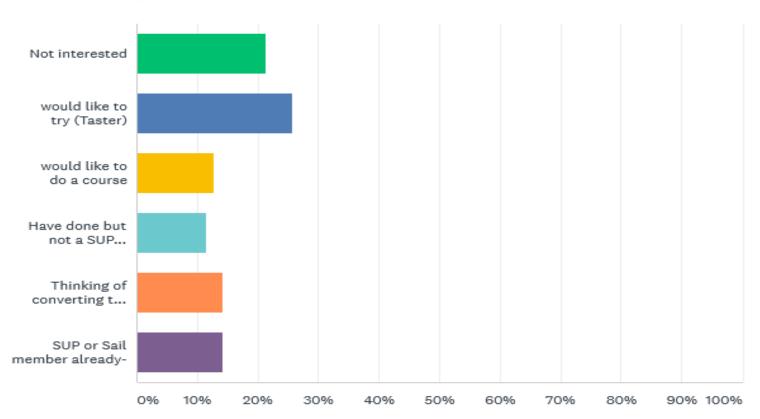
- Adding another weekday evening

The Club offers several activities how interested are you in SUP

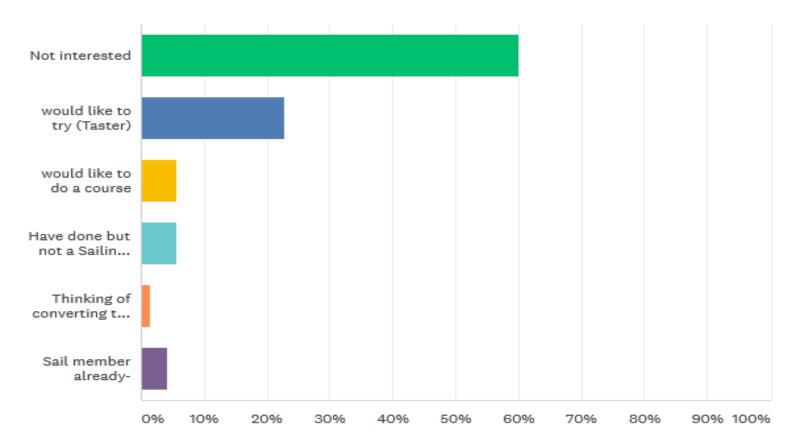

The Club offers several activities how interested are you in Sailing

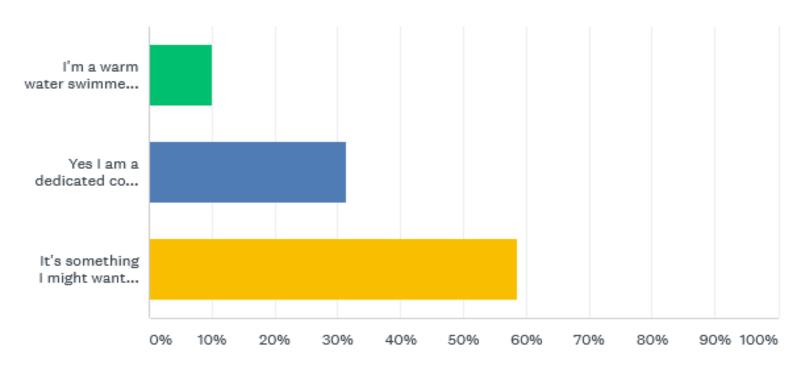

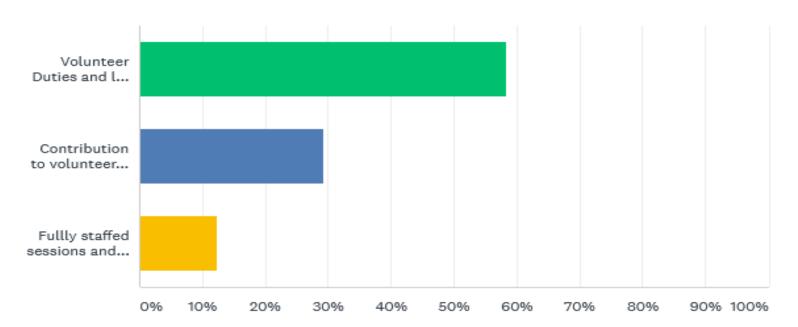
- Quite a lot of interest in winter swimming

- Several want to support and start volunteering

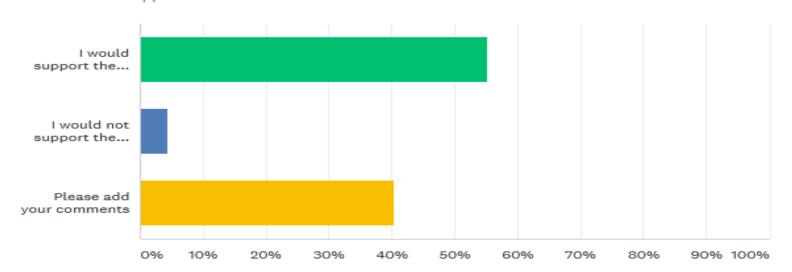

- I cannot underestimate the effect this has had on my mental and physical health. being local I have swum here a lot at the end of the season definitely want to join and help and give back because the club has given me so much
- The club is really welcoming for all and is a beautiful location to swim.
- Great environment for safe swimming, beautiful environment with friendly supportive members.
- I have found the open water swimming experience at Chelmarsh really enjoyable and beneficial. It is great to be able to swim in such beautiful surroundings and have access to a clubhouse with good facilities. The organisers, admin and SUP team do a fantastic job of setting up and running the sessions. It has also given me the opportunity to try other activities including SUP.



 The opportunity to swim in such a safe, clean friendly and supportive environment is not to be underestimated. With the next nearest organised OWS venue to Bridgnorth being more than 40mins drive then to have such an awesome resource on our doorstep is great for the swimmers and for the environment. Look how much less fuel is being used to get to swim venue! And don't forget that with Chelmarsh sailing club having cycle Route 45 running right behind the venue it makes it so readily accessible for cyclists, and runners. This year the swimmer cohort has been a combination of channel swimmers training, triathletes, competitive swimmers using it as additional training venue due to restricted access and numbers at indoor pools, recreational swimmers, friends just having some chat therapy whilst bobbing along float and cake in tow. From young teens to pensioners, streamlined and less well streamlined, they all come, swim, love and return. But more importantly they share; they share knowledge, they share inspiration, they share strengths and they share laughter. In less than 7 months what started out as a few brave fools...yes that includes me....dipping there toes in 10°C water has flourished into a thriving community of like minded individuals each able to use the healing powers of open water swimming to stand taller and stronger and face whatever life throws at us. And on a more personal note, I no longer take prescribed medication for depression and anxiety insteadI swim



- All my other swims are Shrewsbury so having Chelmarsh only 20 mins away is a great benefit to local swimmers. The safety shown by all the support volunteers is a credit to the club. We'd love to try SUP too. Thanks for all you do to provide this service.
- Open water swimming at Chelmarsh has literally changed my life. This is the only venue I've attended and I've built myself up through the season from 3 minutes to 45 minutes.
