



Chelmarsh Sailing Club Clubhouse Re-Opening Procedure Phase 2 July 2021

In line with recent government announcements it has been agreed by the committee that the changing rooms and galley in the clubhouse will be re-opened as of Monday 19 July 2021 and the bar, after evening sailing, on Wednesday 21 July 2021 at 20.00. The opening will be conducted in the following ways, bearing in mind our duty of care to our members, volunteers and staff member:

- As COVID-19 restrictions are lifted, it is important that we all use personal judgement to manage our own risk. All of us can play our part by exercising common sense and considering the risks. While no situation is risk free, there are actions we can take to protect ourselves, and others around us. Following this guidance will help you stay safe and protect others by controlling the spread. Every action to help reduce the spread will reduce any further resurgence of the virus in the coming months.
- Please do not visit the club if you are unwell or think you may have COVID-19. As a reminder, www.gov.uk/government/publications/covid-19-response-summer-2021-roadmap/coronavirus-how-to-stay-safe-and-help-prevent-the-spread, the most important symptoms are recent onset of any of the following:
 1. A new continuous cough
 2. A high temperature
 3. A loss of, or change in, your normal sense of taste or smell
- It will be expected and is recommended that face coverings will be worn in crowded areas of the clubhouse.
- Remain outside the clubhouse as much as possible and if inside make sure windows and doors are open to allow fresh air to circulate within the building.
- Wash your hands regularly using soap and water or use hand sanitiser.
- "Mixed household" sailing is possible but participants may want to consider personal risks and consider wearing facemasks.
- We will continue using track and trace where possible through CO reports and closed Facebook posts. All members will continue to abide by the COVID-19 declarations made as a condition of membership/attendance. These are embedded in Webcollect for all new members, guests and course participants.

- Even though changing rooms, bar and galley will now be open there is no obligation to use them. Please be mindful that some members may chose this option and others should be respectful of their decision.
- Even though you will not need to stay 2 metres apart from people you do not live with many people may prefer that you do. Please be particularly mindful of this in the changing rooms, bar and galley areas of the clubhouse.
- Shared club equipment (i.e. boats, SUPs, safety boats etc) should continue to be sanitised as per current club COVID-19 protocols. The club instructors will continue protocols for shared equipment and boats.
- The bar will be open on Wednesday eve after sailing until the end of August, Thursday & Friday evenings for one hour after swimming and SUPing and Sunday afternoon after sailing.
- Any club crockery, cutlery and glasses must be put in the dishwasher after use and not swilled out under the tap after use. If you put something in the dishwasher and notice it is full or fairly full and it's the end of the session then please put the dishwasher on. Dishwasher tablets are in the cupboard under the sink. Please don't leave dirty dishes in the sink!
- Members should use personal discretion if using showers and changing rooms. Cleaning spray will be available for members to use as it will not be possible to clean high use & touch points regularly during the day when facilities are in use. It is recommended that no more than 2 people should use the men's showers at any one time and windows are kept open when both changing rooms in use.
- Chelmarsh is a members club. If a member wishes to bring a guest for a one off visit then this will need to be pre-approved by a committee member. For track and trace purposes full name, contact phone number of guest and date of visit should then be posted on closed club Facebook page or emailed to: sailing@chelmarshsailing.org. The guest will also need to post or email the COVID-19 declaration below:

"I confirm that I have not had any COVID-19 symptoms in the last 10 days or have, knowingly, been in close contact with someone who has. I will not attend the club if this changes. I have read and understood the Club's policies and will comply with them at all times. I understand the Buddy rules and accept that the act of rescuing or being rescued carries a risk of virus transmission".

Occasional guests may consider joining for 1 month membership via Webcollect. This would then allow such benefits as equipment hire.
